

CBCS

Gour Banga University (UGB) follows the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for its UG courses, now transitioning/implemented with the new Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) from 2024-25, offering flexibility in subjects like Economics, Political Science, History, and English, with detailed syllabi available for specific Honours and General papers (e.g., Microeconomics, Political Theory, Ancient History) on affiliated college websites and UGB portals, focusing on core, generic elective (GE), skill enhancement (SEC), and ability enhancement (AEC) courses under a semester system.

How to Find the Syllabus:

1. **Visit UGB/Affiliated College Websites:** Look for the “Syllabus” or “Academics” section on the official University of Gour Banga (ugb.ac.in) or your specific college’s website (e.g., Malda College, Gour Mahavidyalaya).
2. **Search for Subject-Specific PDFs:** Syllabi are often uploaded as PDF documents, named like “UG_CBCS_Economics_Hons.pdf” or “COURSE-STRUCTURE-CBCS-HONOURS.pdf”.

Key Aspects of UGB CBCS:

- **FYUGP(New):** Implemented from 2024-25, aligning with NEP guidelines.
- **CBCS Structure:** Includes Core Courses (C), Generic Electives (GE), Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), and Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AEC) like Environmental Studies (ENVS).
- **Subject Examples:**
 - **Economics:** Utility, Production Functions, Cost Curves.
 - **Political Science:** Constitutional Govt., Political Theory.
 - **History:** Early Indian History, Ancient Civilizations.
 - **English:** American Literature, Modern Drama.
